Year Group Updates

Nursery & Reception

This week Early Years have been learning all about growing. We have been learning how to grow a plant, planted our own seed, painting pictures of flowers, labelling a plant, retelling the story of Jack and the Beanstalk and making repeated patterns using flowers. In Literacy we have read 'Dear Zoo', created our own story map, put actions to the pictures and described the different animals from the story.

Year 1 & 2

The children all enjoyed taking part in our wow starter day for our new theme. Towers, Tunnels and Turrets. We tried a medieval style meal, jousting and were also learning how to do a Tudor dance. In English we have started reading the book 'The Tunnel' by Anthony Browne and will be writing stories based on this book. In Maths we have been using money and learning about the different values of coins and learning to give change from a given amount.

Please can you make sure your children have a PE kit in school. If your children are unable to do PE can you please give written permission as PE is part of our curriculum. Thank you.

Year 3 & 4

Years 3/4 returned to school enthusiastically this week and really enjoyed the start of our final topic - An American Road Trip.

Children loved our first lesson which involved finding a number of American states on our school playing field!

We shall be writing persuasive texts as well as information texts and narrative in our last 6 weeks of the school year.

In maths Year 3 have been learning 'time' and Year 4 have been working out area and perimeter.

The children have also enjoyed our start to Athletics involving sprint, hurdles, long jump and tennis ball throw.

Chadsmead's Got Talent has had more applications than ever before! Auditions will be held during the morning of Monday 18th June. All acts must have their instruments/ music etc in school on that morning to be able to audition. There will inevitably be some children who are disappointed and not get through. If your child has entered, please encourage them to be well-rehearsed and ready for that day. Fingers crossed!

Year 5

After a relaxing half term holiday we are back ready for the last half term of the academic year.

Year 5 have started their new theme this week: 'Off with her head'. Our WOW starter included playing Tudor games or making Tudor-style sweets out of marzipan. Some of the children have also been using timelines to order events of the Tudor period. Thank you to those who completed the homework project. Once again we have had some fantastic work brought into school.

In writing, Year 5 are studying a narrative piece – The Whipping boy – and in maths they have been learning about shape and line graphs.

Year 6

Year 6 are continuing to work really hard on their assessed pieces of writing. To balance out the harder academic work, lots of fun is being had whilst learning dances with Mr Stevens. Pupils have had photographs taken ready for their leavers books.

Next week we look forward to a trip to Friary to see their performance of Bugsy Malone on Tuesday and also a session entitled Drones and Robots on Wednesday. We would like to remind parents/carers that PE sessions are on Tuesdays and Wednesdays - please send pupils in with kits to prevent a call home.

Our first group of police cadets will have their graduation on Tuesday next week and the rest of Year 6 are now beginning their police cadet training.
