<u>N.B.</u> It is important to note that whilst we are extremely pleased with our results the figures show only attainment i.e. what the children achieved.

<u>Most importantly</u>, as a school we are measured by PROGRESS scores. These scores are worked out by the DfE and sent to us in the Autumn term.

We are able to get a rough idea of our progress scores by looking at how our Year 6 children progressed since Year 2. Initial forecasts are showing a LARGE IMPROVEMENT in all subjects which is a critical step in the school being judged to show significant improvement.

I would like to thank all staff for their efforts to achieve these results. It has required a lot of dedication, commitment and hard work. Most importantly the children have responded admirably to their challenges and made us all proud.

After School Clubs in September


Letters will be sent home to reserve your child a place on after school clubs week commencing 4th September.

The zig –zags are there for a purpose.


To provide a clear area in which children can cross MORE safely.
