#### Parking information for parents/carers

Parent/carers reminded to park responsibly outside schools.

With children back to school for the new term, parents are being urged to put safety first by parking responsibly during drop-off and pick-up times.

The Staffordshire County Council campaign is calling on people to park considerately and reminding drivers that Civil Enforcement Officers will be visiting roads near schools right across the county. Any vehicle observed parked on yellow lines or in a restricted area could be issued with a penalty notice, if not observed picking up or dropping off a passenger.

The campaign is also reminding drivers to switch off their engines when parked up, which is good for the environment and people's health, and helps reduce pollution.

It is hoped that the campaign will also urge parents to consider alternative modes of transport such as walking, cycling, scooting 'park and stride' or a walking bus. These all help to reduce congestion and pollution outside schools which is good for the environment, good for parents pockets and helps keep people active.



# Reception

# Year 1 & 2

Year 1 and 2 have made a fabulous start to the year. We have already started on our new theme of 'Muck, mess and mixtures' and have been doing investigations and writing linked to the topic.

# Year 3 & 4

Year 3 and 4 have been focussing on the initial stages of digestion. We have investigated how our teeth slice and crush our food and how our tongue pushes the food around our mouths. We have also made tooth impressions to identify our own teeth. During maths we are learning about place value and identifying the value of digits in 3 and 4 digit numbers. It has been a great start to our new school year.

# Year 5

This week Year 5 have been thinking about hygiene and asking 'How hygienic were the Middle Ages?' They have been detectives and have looked at factors that led to the Black Death.

In Talk 4 Writing they have begun to innovate a text about the plague and are learning how to improve their writing. They have focused on dialogue and describing settings this week.

# Year 6

Year 6 have continued to impress teachers with their work this week. In maths, pupils have been working on place value and addition using the column method. In English, children are all enjoying the book 'Wonder' and have discussed the theme of kindness and being able to empathise with others. Our topic of ID has led us to think carefully about our own identity and we have written honest descriptions of ourselves. We are looking forward to our residential trip next week and discovering more about our own strengths and weaknesses.
