## **End of Year Reports**

#### **Children's Transition**

Children will spend time in their new classrooms with next year's teachers on the mornings of Tuesday 8th July and Thursday 10th July. This will happen during the school day and no lunchtime arrangements will be affected.

### **Children's Workbooks**

Children in Years 1-6 will be bringing home their completed books from this year on Thursday 17th July. It would be helpful if you could send your child with a carrier bag on this day. If books aren't taken by the end of the term then we will dispose of them in school. Children in Nursery and Reception will not be bringing home their Learning Journey's until January 2025. This is because the curriculum specifies a transition phase in the Autumn term (especially when moving from an Early Years Curriculum to the National Curriculum). We will keep them safe and refer to them regularly. We shall send them home in early January. You will receive your child's writing and maths books on the 17th July.
