Maths Skills Workshop Thursday 6th November 9am

The school is delighted to have been selected to work with the independent charity National Numeracy on an exciting project which encourages children and families to do maths together.

As part of the project, we will be introducing National Numeracy's Family Maths scrapbooks and activities. These are activities that help children and families to explore everyday maths at home together. They link the maths that children are learning at school with life outside the classroom.

You don't need any special knowledge or equipment to work on the activities. Just talking about everyday maths can help develop children's maths confidence. You might like to take photos, draw pictures, write sums, or create diagrams in the scrapbooks – it's up to you!

National Numeracy have provided a scrapbook for every child. We encourage all families to support their children's learning by getting involved with the activities.

To support this, we are holding a workshop for parents and carers who feel their own Maths skills are not what they once were; would like some further support with their own Maths or would just like the opportunity to chat about Maths and/or increase their confidence with Number. No Maths is involved (this is not a lesson or test!) – merely an opportunity to share opinions and maybe alleviate some worries through great support and advice.

The workshop will take place on Thursday 6th November from 9-10am in the KS2 hall.

However you feel about maths, you can make a big difference to your child's numeracy learning.
