School Environment (Inside)

School Environment (Outside)

School councillors have ongoing concerns about broken / missing breaktime bucket equipment. Mrs Cadman shared future plans of break/lunchtimes

Healthy Eating

School councillors have requested jugs of eater again for Y6 like last year; children would like a variety of snack options for break times in KS2 - To be discussed with GG

Happiness and Well Being

School councillors have no concerns about the happiness / wellbeing of children at Chadsmead however they recognise that playtimes are where disagreements and fall outs mainly occur due to social skills.
