### STEPPING OUT: PEDESTRIAN TRAINING FOR 7 - 9 YEAR OLDS

Your child is about to take part in a basic pedestrian awareness scheme, which involves classroom work and visits to roads near to the school. To carry out the project, a number of volunteers are needed to help observe the children and maintain suitable adult to pupil ratios.

*Observed Walk*        it is **essential** to have at least eight volunteers who will be positioned along the route. This will take place on Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> February and each permitted child will walk the route by themselves whilst being observed by the volunteers and staff.
