SEPTEMBER 2026 – JULY 2027 Instrumental Tuition for Current Year 2–5 Pupils



We are now organising instrumental music tuition for the next academic year (September 2026 – July 2027).

Please complete the form overleaf if you would like your child to:

- continue their current instrumental lessons into next year, or
- begin learning an instrument from September 2026

Important information:

- Lessons are booked for the full academic year and places are limited. It is not usually possible to join part-way through the year.
- Please discuss the options with your child before applying.
- Completed forms must be returned to the school office by **Wednesday 10th June 2026**.

Commitment and expectations:

- Pupils are expected to attend lessons regularly and practise between sessions.
- By signing up, you are committing to the full academic year.
- A deposit must be paid before lessons begin in September to secure your child's place.
- If your child withdraws from lessons, **the full annual fee will still be payable.**

Small Group Tuition:

- Taught by specialist instrumental teachers
- Typically 20-minute lessons in groups of up to four pupils of similar ability
- Cost: **£165 per year, per instrument**
- Lessons may take place during the school day, at breaktime or lunchtime
- Pupils will need their own instrument (either their own or for free through Entrust)
School keyboards, school guitars and the school drum kit are provided for those lessons

Financial support:

Reduced rates are available for pupils eligible for free school meals. Please contact the school office for further details.
