



Year 6 Home Learning

Reading

Read at home for at least 15 minutes a day, 5x a week. Establish a regular reading routine at home.

Pupils must have their reading book in school every day for additional independent reading time in class.

Pupils choose their own reading book from the library within their ZPD range.

Once completed, they will quiz their book. If they pass the quiz, the total words in that book will be added to their individual word score.



Pupils are awarded certificates in regular reading assemblies.

Spelling

Spellings are given out at the start of each half term. We use Y6 Grammarsaurus morphology units with additional Y5/6 statutory spellings.

(Some children may have different spellings depending on their needs.)

Spelling tests are on Friday mornings.

Please ensure the children are prepared and ready for these.

Children should practice their spellings at home in the green spelling homework book provided. We encourage children to print words in spelling tests rather than joining.

A regular routine is essential ahead of SATS.



English & Maths

English and maths homework is given on a Thursday and is marked in the lesson the following Tuesday.

The children have separate purple homework books for English and maths since the work is returned to different teachers.

Work should be presented as neatly as it would in class using blue pen or pencil.

Please encourage the children to complete homework as soon as possible and not leave it until the last minute. Building a good homework routine now will make the transition to high school easier.



Times Tables

Practise 5x a week for 10 minutes.

Creative Homework

Creative homework is given at the start of each holiday, usually instead of the maths and English homework.

Children will have options to choose from with one task expected, though the children can do more if they wish.

The date for the work to be handed in will be indicated on the homework- usually this is the second week after the holiday to allow time for those who have been away to complete the work.
