What an exciting first week back...

We kick started our theme 'Are we there yet?' by flying to our first destination; Australia. We have learnt lots of different facts about Australia and have completed lots of exciting activities, including drawing and labelling Australian animals, completed aboriginal art, found Australia on the world map, painting boomerangs, listened to Australian music and much more.

In Maths Mastery this week we have been exploring the numbers 5-10. We have been recognising the numbers and counting out the correct amount of objects. We have also been drawing the correct amount of objects to match the number. During our maths meetings, we have been naming and describing 2D shapes as well as practicing addition and subtraction using the part-part whole model.

In literacy this week we have been reading a new story 'Naughty Bus'. We have been learning about settings and have written our own sentences to describe the setting in the story.

In theme this week, we have learning all about different types of transport. We put them into categories - air, water, road, track, path. We talked about the similarities and differences for the different types of transport.
