Message from Early Years

We have had another super week getting to know the children. The children have built strong relationships with adults and their peers. We have been learning all about Chadsmead's community. Reception children have been on a special walk around the school to meet the staff and children. They were very excited to meet new faces. We have even taken pictures of the staff at Chadsmead to put into our small world next week.

In literacy this week we have been reading the story 'Lost and Found'. The Reception children have even started to write in their special writing books! We have also started our Maths Mastery lessons. The children have had one lesson where they were learning all about a repeated pattern.

The Reception children have started phonics following our scheme RWI. The first sounds we are learning are m, a, s, d and t. The children are learning how to blend and segment the letters to make words such as m-a-d, m-u-m, m-u-d, s-a-t.

During choosing time this week the children have had lots of fun painting penguins and bears, counting objects, talking about daily routines, making bears using the playdough, building their name using the magnetic letters, making patterns and letters in the glitter and shaving foam and threading.
