Welcome back to the second half term ©

This week we have been learning all about Diwali and Bonfire night. The children have created their own fireworks using a range of resources (pipe cleaners, toilet roll tubes and forks), making rocket names, building CVC words, creating henna designs for Diwali, writing cards, colouring Rangoli patterns, exploring black sparkly playdough and threading beads on star pipe cleaners, just to name a few.

In Literacy this week, we have been using adjectives to describe fireworks. We watched a clip of a firework display and talked about what they looked and sounded like. We came up with some super adjectives such as pop, fizz, whoosh, loud, bang. We made a poster to tell people how to keep safe during Bonfire night. In maths this week, we have been looking at adding two groups together. We have been using the vocabulary 'addition, add, plus, altogether, part, whole'.

Our theme this half term is 'Can we explore it'. This week we have explored melting chocolate and made edible sparklers by dipping bread sticks into the melted chocolate and sprinkles, YUMMY! Next week, we will be reading the story 'We're going on a Bear Hunt' and will be completing activities based on this story.
