

What has your child been learning about in class this week?

Years 1 & 2

This week in Years $1\ \&\ 2$ we have been completing term 2 assessments to check on the children's learning and retained knowledge. The children have worked hard and achieved some good results.

In writing, Year 1 have been working on the story of 'Norman the Slug with the Silly Shell'. Year 2 have been finishing writing verses for their mini-beast poems.

We have been sorting and classifying mini-beasts in science and revisiting the life processes to identify why something is alive, dead or has never been alive. We used the acronym 'MRS GREN' to help us decide if things are alive or not.

Years 3 & 4

It has been a busy week for the Years 3 & 4 in school. We have been working hard on getting some of our assessments completed over this week and next. This has involved tests in reading, maths, VGPS and spellings. It is super to see how well everyone responds to these assessments as they are sometimes quite challenging. We are aware that not everyone loves doing them but everyone gets on and completes the job.

We have launched our Roman Theme this week - 'I am Warrior' - a study of the Roman Empire.

We began this by using our own school timeline where we can give children a perspective on where different eras in history lie.

Years 5

Year 5 this week have experienced an extended arts week focusing on the artist, illustrator and writer Peter Thorpe. They have learnt about his style of art work and learnt how to merge and mix chalk pastels to create three-dimensional effects on spheres as well as experimenting with different paint techniques to create backgrounds, middle grounds and foregrounds in their art work. Children have enjoyed making their own artistic choices and will be putting together a virtual gallery for everyone to see.

Years 6

Year 6 have thoroughly enjoyed their week at Whitemoor Lakes. We have tackled many activities enabling the children to display teamwork, resilience, bravery, collective support, ambition etc. everyone has tried their hardest and have pushed themselves as far as they can. All children are both eating and sleeping well. They have organised themselves pleasingly and have received many compliments for their behaviour, manners, and attitude to learning from Whitemoor Lakes staff. We are very proud of them.
