We have had another fantastic week in Early Years. We have been reading the story 'The Three Little Pigs' and have been completing some super writing. We sequenced the pictures from the story and wrote about the events that happened. We are so proud of the children and how far they have come with their writing!

We have also been learning all about dinosaurs and are waiting patiently for the eggs to hatch in the classroom. We have been completing lots of exciting activities such as painting dinosaurs, writing what dinosaurs would say if they could talk, practicing addition, matching numeral to quantity, weighing dinosaurs, threading, retelling stories using the puppet theatre and discovering dinosaur bones in the dinosaur museum.

During Maths Mastery lessons, Reception children have been looking at numbers within 20. The children have been learning to put numbers in order to 20, counting objects to 20 and finding out what is one greater/ fewer than a number within 20.
