How do we keep children safe at Chadsmead?

Visitors have to sign in at the office
Visitors are given badges so we can spot who has been signed in
We practise fire drills and lockdown
We move children away from danger as in the recent flood
There are locks on doors up high
There is a huge fence round the outside of school
There are keypads on each door – teachers have cards
Gates are shut by staff each day
Teachers meet and greet us at the doors
Teachers have walkie talkies and use email to talk to others
Permission is needed to walk home, go on trips or have your photograph taken
Teachers do training to keep us safe
We are encouraged to tell a trusted adult if we are worried
We have worry boxes in every classroom
Lunchtime supervisors keep us safe at lunchtime
We have medical boxes in every classroom
Teachers know about children who have medical needs
Medical boxes go everywhere including lunchtimes
There are first aid posters around school - yellow one - to tell people who are first aid trained
