

Stowe Bool




Around Stowe Bool is a large willow tree known as Johnson's Willow. Samuel Johnson liked to visit the tree whenever he returned to Lichfield.


A long time ago, Stowe Bool would have been used as a resevoir, supplying surrounding houses with water.

It is only used for recereational purposes now where people can fish and sometimes you may see people in boats or canoes!


