What a super week we have had in Early Years. We have been continuing to read the story 'The Gruffalo' and have completed some exciting activities such as character shape pictures, exploring scrambles snake, cutting a spiral snake, making patterns in glitter, labeling the characters from the story, making Gruffalos out of playdough, painting a Gruffalo and pegging purple prickles onto the Gruffalo's back.

During maths this week, we have been exploring numbers 1-4 by drawing objects to represent the numbers, counting objects and matching the number, as well as practicing writing them.

In literacy this week we have been writing all about the Gruffalo. We have been writing adjectives to describe the Gruffalo such as purple prickles, big orange eyes.

In theme this week, we have been learning all about Autumn. We watched short clips of wild animals that we might see in Autumn and things that happen during this season. We chose an Autumn animal and drew a representation of it.
