Today I want to help you understand more about the Phonics Screening Check.

In December 2018, research found that nearly 90% of children who passed the phonics check taken in Year 1 reached or exceeded the expected standard in reading in Year 6.


What is the Phonics Screening Check?

- Children read 40 words.
- It takes between two and five minutes.

Phonics Screening Check is a word reading test that all Year 1s undertake in June.

If they do not manage to read approx. 32 of the words, they are given extra support, and repeat the check at the end of Year 2.

Picture Phrases




We teach children sounds using a picture phrases to help them remember.

'Special Friends'




'Special Friends', 'Fred Talk', read the word




Can you spot the special friends?




Read Write Inc. Phonics – information for parents

What can you do?

- 1. Use 'Special Friends', 'Fred Talk', read the word' to read words
- 2. Practise reading sounds speedily -'review, review, review'
- 3. Listen to your child read their Storybook every day
- 4. Discuss the meaning of words if your child does not know what they have read.
