


Newsletter Friday 29th April 2022

What has your child been learning about in class this week?

Years 1 & 2

In KS1 we have started our new theme 'The Scented Garden'. We have already been out on a plant hunt, looking for common plants around our school grounds. We have also started an investigation to identify what plants need to grow healthy. We will observe our investigation over the half term.

In our English writing, we have started to learn about explanation texts. We will be writing our own explanations over the next few weeks.

In our maths work, Year 1 have started learning about fractions. They have been learning about halves of shapes and identifying equal and unequal parts. Year 2 have begun adding and subtracting to and from 2-digit numbers.

Thank you to everyone who have sent in some creative homework to share. If you have been planting at home, please take photographs and send them into school via MyEd for us to share in class.

Years 3 & 4

It has been nice to see the children return to school this week after their Easter break. They have been keen to get on with their learning and have shown a great attitude. We have enjoyed learning all about Queen Boudicca this week and what exactly happened as she led a rebellion against the Romans. Firstly, we took notes as we learned and then we wrote an information report. Maths has been interesting this week with the children in Year 3 working on fractions and the children in Year 4 working on decimals. Both topics are obviously linked and can prove quite challenging. To end the week we have designed, made and evaluated a Roman Mosaic. This has seen some really creative work with some excellent end results.

Finally, Year 4 have moved back to Sycamore classroom after the Great Flood of October 2021! The children have loved returning to their classroom and are excited to be in such a smart, new room!

Years 5 & 6

Welcome back to Years 5 & 6, we are pleased to say that the majority of pupils have come back well motivated and obviously enthused to learn more about WW2. We have already received some excellent homework.

This week we have begun our new class text titled 'Friend or Foe', written by Michael Morpurgo. In maths, Year 6 have looked at their homework and tried to solve any difficulties encountered, in preparation for their upcoming SATs. Year 5 have focused on time and converting between seconds, minutes, hours etc, as well as solving time related word problems.

In Year 6 writing, we have revised objectives from within our VGPS curriculum. In Year 5 writing, we have looked at features used in some war poems and then performed these poems as a group.

Our theme has started with us looking at the causes of WW2, significant figures involved and a timeline of significant events. We have then looked at rationing and tried to devise a weekly food plan taking account of availability and cost.
