This week we have been continuing to be explorers by using our senses to taste different foods, guess what was in the feely boxes, smelling different scents, making explorer hats, making 2D shape bears, finding out about the world by using an atlas and a globe, writing about what we would need if we went exploring, completing jigsaws and much more.

In maths this week, we have been exploring using everyday language to talk about size and weight. We have used super vocabulary such as **heavy, heavier, heaviest, light, lighter, lightest, long, longer, longest, short, shorter, shortest.**
