This week we have been reading a new story called 'The Little Red Hen'. We have talked about the characters, setting and have even written our own speech in a speech bubble!

We have been completing some exciting activities during choosing time such as painting our own farm animals, investigating the Spring area in the classroom, writing about our holiday news, exploring the clocks and talking about our daily routine, exploring the mud with farm animals and paying for items in the toy shop.
