# What has your child been learning about in class this week?

#### Years 1 & 2

Last week's assessments have shown some great progress in the children's learning and development. In Years 1 and 2 we have had yet another very busy week this week. We have started learning about letter writing in preparation for writing letters to Father Christmas. In our maths lessons, Year 2 have begun learning about multiplication and linking it to repeated addition and using arrays to practically show multiplication facts. Year 1 have been learning about 1 more and 1 less than numbers to 20. We have learned about some very unsavoury real-life pirates from the past in our history theme lessons. Our Christmas performance is coming along very nicely and the children have done an excellent job of remembering their individual parts as well as the words to all the songs. It will be a super performance and we look forward to seeing lots of you next week.

#### Years 3 & 4

It is getting really Christmassy in Years 3 & 4. We have had a great week - especially with our festive film night on Wednesday. It was an excellent night watching the old favourite 'Home Alone 1' and 'The Nightmare before Christmas' with the class. The classrooms had a lovely atmosphere as it grew dark outside and we rearranged our seats to create a 'cinema effect'. The children seemed mesmerised by the movie and hopefully just by all being together and doing this sort of thing they will remember it for a long time to come. We also had a fabulous time at the Christmas fair which has proved a real success. Next week is our last week, with the Year 3 Christmas service on Monday and the Year 4 Christmas service on Tuesday. Whilst in reading, they have finished their class text 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe,' we have thoroughly enjoyed this book, especially the script version we have used.

Theme this week has been science based: we have looked at reversible and irreversible changes and have looked at how to separate a variety of solids and liquids.
