We have had another fantastic week in Early Years. We have been continuing to read the story 'The Three Little Pigs' and have been completing some super writing independently. We have been writing adjectives to describe the big bad wolf and the little pigs. We have also been writing what the characters said in the story and writing lists of materials needed to build their own house.

We have been completing lots of exciting activities when choosing in the classroom including measuring our hands and feet using cubes, reading instructions (can you jump?), practicing addition and subtraction, exploring things that we see in Spring, making our own stories using the puppets and making a patterned egg using pom poms and paints.
