

Daily lessons are here!

On Monday April 20th, the BBC and Government launched a new learning platform; BBC Bitesize Daily, which offers DAILY, PLANNED, RESOURCED lessons to help support you and your child's/children's home-school learning.

Every week day in the upcoming weeks you can find an English and Maths lesson, as well as a 3rd lesson from a selection of other subjects; History, Music, Science etc.

Lessons are laid out in a daily (and dated) format for pupils to follow from home. The lessons feature a mix of videos, animations, practice activities, quizzes and games, - created by teachers and presented by celebs and teachers.

No signing up or logging in is required!

Lessons can be accessed using home computers, laptops or i-Pads.

To access lessons:

- Click on 'Start a lesson'
- Select the relevant year group for your child
- Choose your lesson from those offered

The 'Home learning' section explains the focus, content and activity of the lesson selected.

Each lesson is separated into 3 easy to follow sections: LEARN - this may be a short video to introduce the learning PRACTISE - offers an opportunity to have a go ACTIVITIES - 1 or 2 learning tasks to complete - you will find it useful to have paper and a pencil for the completion of these
