Dear Parents and Carers

We are very excited to invite children in Years 1– 6 to attend Dick Whittington at The Lichfield Garrick.

Year 1/2 – Wednesday 5th December 1.30pm Performance
(Coach travel arranged, collection from classroom at 4.15pm)

Year 5/6 – Wednesday 5th December 1.30pm Performance
(Children will walk to and from the venue and have an early lunch prior to leaving, collection from classroom at 4.15pm)

Year 3/4 – Friday 7th December 9.30am Performance
(Children will walk to and from the venue and have lunch when they return to school)

To enable the trip to take place we will require a payment of £12.00 per child to cover the cost of the entrance fee. Free School Meal children will be required to pay £6.00. (This does not include those children in Years 1 and 2 who automatically receive Universal Free School Meals). Please note refunds for absence on the day cannot be made.

All children are required to wear school uniform, a suitable outdoor warm waterproof coat and wear sensible footwear. Hats, scarves and gloves may also be required if the weather deteriorates for those children walking to and from the theatre.

The performance should last for approximately 2 hours 30 minutes (NB timings are approximate at this stage). Children will then return to school.
