#### Years 1 & 2

The children in Year 1 and Year 2 have had a very busy week. We have started learning about a new story in our theme time called 'The 'Disgusting Sandwich'. The children have produced some fabulous writing.

In maths, Year 2 have been working on partitioning two digit numbers and read and writing numbers in words. Year 1 have been working on reading and writing numerals to 10 to make sure they are secure. They have also been working on number bonds to 10. In our theme we have been thinking about changing materials. The vocabulary we are working on is opaque and transparent.

This week we are sending the children home with some homework in their purple homework book. Please can we ask you to support your child to complete this?

### Years 3 & 4

This week we have drawn up our Class Charter and agreed the rules we think are sensible for us all to enjoy a safe, friendly working environment. We have learned to celebrate some of the things which make us proud and how we can be kind to each other.

In theme lessons it has been fun biting into a piece of polystyrene and identifying where our teeth are what their purpose is.

Year 3 have been learning about deriving new number facts from known facts e.g. 16+5=21 so 21-5=6 whilst Year 4 have been learning about place value. Also children have loved our new guided reading text Demon Dentist and also seem very keen to quiz on their reading books. All in all, a very busy week!

#### Year 5

Year 5 this week have been looking in more detail at our Egyptian theme, whilst Year 6 have been at Whitemoor Lakes. We have learnt about Egyptian Numbers, made Egyptian style collars and learnt about squared and cubed numbers. In addition, we have written poetry and descriptions of places in Egypt and have continued to enjoy our Egyptian whole class reader - The Phoenix Code. We are looking forward to Friday afternoon's showcase of our work.


#### Year 6
