Transition for Nursery Children

Ordinarily, we would now be writing to you to invite you in to a number of events and meetings. However, due to the current situation this is not possible. As I am sure you will appreciate as a school, we have had to adapt rapidly over the past few weeks. It is definitely an unusual and challenging time at the moment, and we know you and your child might be feeling worried about the transition into Nursery this September. We want to reassure you that we are here for you every step of the way. Starting school is a milestone for both you and your child. It is a time to be celebrated. Whilst we understand that current measures make this more difficult, we will do everything we can to ensure it stays a positive experience for everyone. In order to follow the Government's guidelines on social distancing, we've had to adjust our arrangements for supporting this year's transition.

Our current plans include:

Week Commencing 6th July 2020 – Miss Morton Early Years Lead will telephone all parents/carers to discuss preparation for September. We shall use contact details provided at the time of application – if these have changed please let us know as soon as possible on 01543 421850.

Week Commencing 7th September 2020 - We would like to invite you and your child to 'stay and play sessions'. This will give you and your child the opportunity to meet the staff and explore their new classroom. There will be two groups and during your telephone conversation with Miss Morton, she will book your attendance at these.

The sessions will be held on:

GROUP A

- 9.30am 11.00am Monday 7th and Tuesday 8th September with parent/carer
- 9.30am 10.30am Wednesday 9th September for your child to stay and play on their own.





GROUP B

- 1.45pm 3.15pm Wednesday 9th September with parent/carer
- 9.30am 11.00am Thursday 10th September with parent/carer
- 9.30am 10.30am Friday 11th September for your child to stay and play on their own.

Week Commencing 14th September 2020 – Your child will start nursery.
