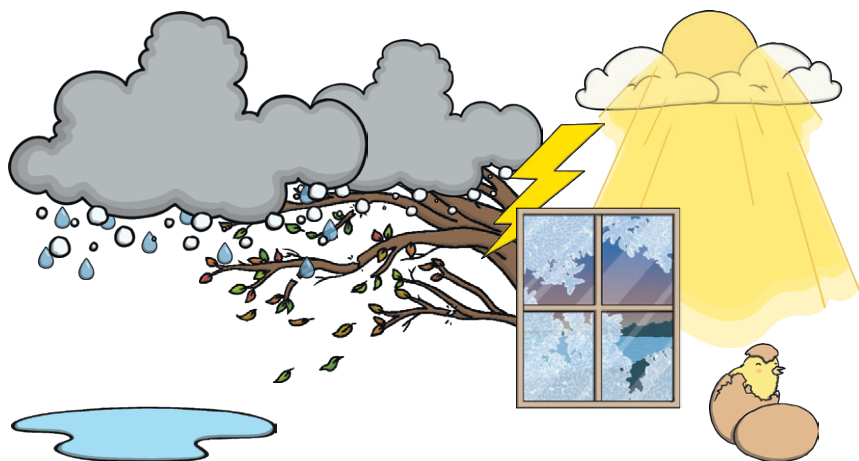


Spring Storms

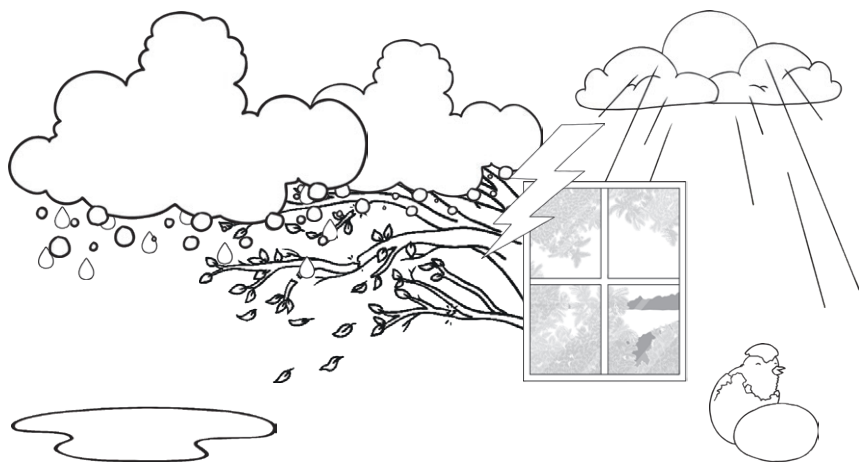
