We have been continuing our journey around the world and have visited the USA this week.

We have been learning all about the USA and its famous landmarks. We have completed lots of activities such as making their flag using peg boards, practicing our cutting skills by cutting out toppings for a pizza, making different foods out of playdough (burgers, hotdogs, cheesy fries etc), observational drawing of the White House, using the construction resources to make the Empire State building and much more.
