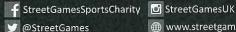
Questionnaire

The questionnaire we ask every child who takes part in Let's Get Physical to complete tells us whether the amount of physical activity they do changes over time. Your child may have answered the questionnaire at school. If they haven't, please help them do it at home if you have a computer, tablet or phone that is connected to the internet. They need to do this once at the very start of the project, and again after 3 and 6 months - but don't worry, we will send reminders to the school about that! It only takes 5 minutes each time. The information is vital for us to work out whether the project is working and also so we can get funding to keep all the sessions free!

As well as running the sessions at school, we are offering free activities outside school too. These will be taking place at Life Church, WS13 6TS, or Burntwood Leisure Centre, WS7 3XH. These are free for everyone and we warmly welcome brothers, sisters, parents and other family members to come and join in the fun. Please do come and see what it's all about.
