‘How many pebbles on a beach?’

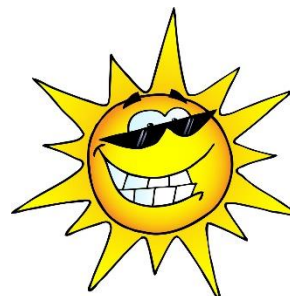
During this theme we will be exploring things we would find on the beach and who might live in a rock pool. We will explore life as a pirate and what it would be like to live at sea.
