


Message from Mrs Grainger

Message from Early Years

WOW! What a fantastic week we have had. This week has been our 'WOW Week' where the children have completed lots of child led learning. The children have been showing us everything they have learnt over the last 3 weeks. The children have had some AMAZING ideas during their play such as making a train using the large crates and construction shapes, making volcanoes using the small world resources, painting pictures of animals that live in the rainforest, making shelters for the rainforest animals using large material and crates, making robots using box modelling, practicing counting rainforest animals, learning all about space which was inspired by one of the children making a rocket, talking about what is a reflection, exploring what a compass is and what it is used for, building pirate ships, making pirate maps and much more!

In maths this week, we have been exploring finding one more than a number to 10. The children were introduced to a ten frame and used this to help them count the objects correctly. The children were able to use the vocabulary **one greater** and **one more** as well as putting it into a sentence such as **one more than six is seven**.
