## Christmas Card Project 2021

This term we have decided to participate in a 'Christmas Design Project' run by Cauliflower Cards. The project aims to encourage pupils' creativity and design skills whilst also raising funds for our school. Your child will shortly be creating his/her own Christmas design which can then be professionally printed to produce personalized Christmas Cards, Gift Labels, Wrapping Paper and/or Mugs should you wish to.

### What is Available to Purchase?

#### Cards

- 12x A6 Cards, Varnished with 12x envelopes
- Pupils' design printed on front & name as designer on back
- Wide range of inside greetings (or leave blank) or create a custom message

#### Mugs

- 10oz Durham Mug
- Pupils design printed on back and front & set into choice of backgrounds
- Custom message available & pupils' name printed next to handle

#### Wrapping Paper

- 2x A1 Sheets - Pupils' design printed on a choice of backgrounds
- Tags that match the chosen background

#### Adhesive Gift Labels

- 16x adhesive labels with pupils' design and name

#### Spiral Bound Books

- 1x A5 Landscape or portrait spiral bound book

Once your child has created their Christmas card in school in the next few weeks, you will be sent their art work and a pupil order form. You will then be able to make your order and payment through the Cauliflower cards website using a unique code located at the top of your child's pupil order form. You will need to refer to the order form for all the instructions when you receive it. Each order form must be unique so when you receive it, please do not photocopy the form for other members of your family - you will be able to get extra copies from your school.

Once you have placed your order online, you will need to return your child's artwork and any other information required by **Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> September 2021**. Your child's artwork will then be sent to the company so that your order can be made. Products will be delivered to school by the start of December and then forwarded to you.

It is anticipated that it would be very exciting for your child to see his/her work as a finished printed product, the cards themselves are great for sending a more personal greeting to friends and family at Christmas and the Mugs are great for gifts!

We do hope you will find the project exciting and I look forward to seeing all of the Christmas cards the Children make.
