




Erasmus Darwin's House

Stowe Bool




Lichfield Landmarks

Around Stowe Pool is a large willow tree known as Johnson's Willow. Samuel Johnson liked to visit the tree whenever he returned to Lichfield.


A long time ago, Stowe Pool would have been used as a reservoir, supplying surrounding houses with water.




