This week has been another very busy but super week!

We have been continuing to learn all about space. In literacy, we have made our own aliens out of 2D shapes and have been writing adjectives to describe them. We have been reading the story 'Aliens love underpants' and have completed activities around the story including aliens in gloop, directing the beebots to the aliens, making planets out of playdough for the aliens, counting aliens, drawing aliens and planets on the interactive whiteboard and much more.

In maths this week, we have been looking at combining two groups and subtracting using partitioning. We have been using a part-part whole model to help us to solve the number sentences.

An example of the new vocabulary and sentences that we used in maths:

6 is my whole.
2 is one of my parts
4 is the other part
6 subtract 2 is equal to 4
