

Message from Early Years

What a super week we have had in Early Years. We have completed some exciting activities linked to our theme 'Why do squirrels hide their nuts?'. We have been drawing representations of the Gruffalo and autumn animals, creating our own hedgehog using paints, counting conkers and matching them to the numbered scarecrows, colouring and writing about Autumn pictures, colour by number Autumn pictures and making hedgehogs using playdough.

During maths this week, we have been continuing to explore numbers to six, finding one more/ fewer than a given number. We have also been ordering numbers 0-6.

In literacy this week, we have been writing adjectives to describe things in Autumn. We have described autumn animals, conkers and trees in Autumn.

In theme this week, we have been following instructions to make some yummy 'Gruffalo Crumble' (apple crumble).
