Message from Early Years

We have been continuing our journey around the world and have visited China this week.

We have been learning all about China including Chinese New Year. We have completed lots of activities such as making a dragon puppet, building number puzzles, making the Great Wall of China using the construction resources, learnt how to use chopsticks, used paints to write Chinese symbols, learnt all about the year of the rat, adding two digit numbers using beads, threading beads onto dragons, making lanterns and much more.

In Maths Mastery this week, we have been exploring ordinal numbers as well as learning to use mathematical resources to count on when adding. We have been making our own Mathematical stories.
