Year 5/6 Visit to Black Country Living Museum: Tuesday 9th June 2020

Dear Parents and Carers

As part of the History curriculum for the Summer term, the children in Years 5/6 will be visiting the Black Country Living Museum on Tuesday 9th June 2020.

The trip will be an opportunity for the children to experience hands on what life was like for children living in Victorian Britain including a visit to the mine and school classroom experience.

We will <u>depart immediately after registration at 9.00am</u> prompt and <u>return to school for approximately 4.00pm.</u>

To enable the trip to take place we will require a payment of £25.00 per child to cover the cost of the coach and entrance into the museum. Free School Meal children will be required to pay £12.50. Payments can be made by instalment. Please note refunds for absence on the day cannot be made.

All children are required to wear school uniform, please ensure children bring along a waterproof coat and wear sensible outdoor footwear. Please note children will spend a lot of the day outside and so may require extra clothing layers. All children will need a packed lunch. If your child receives Free School Meals they are entitled to a free packed lunch, please notify the school office as soon as possible if required.

Please make the appropriate payment via Parent Pay by Monday 1st June, you will also be asked to tick a consent box as part of the payment process which authorises your son/daughter to attend the trip.

Children who have prescribed medicines (e.g. Asthma Inhalers, Epi-pens etc.) MUST bring these with them.
