**Year 5/6 Visit to Black Country Living Museum:  
Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> June 2020**

Dear Parents and Carers

As part of the History curriculum for the Summer term, the children in Years 5/6 will be visiting the Black Country Living Museum on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> June 2020.

The trip will be an opportunity for the children to experience hands on what life was like for children living in Victorian Britain including a visit to the mine and school classroom experience.

We will **depart immediately after registration at 9.00am** prompt and **return to school for approximately 4.00pm.**

To enable the trip to take place we will require a payment of £25.00 per child to cover the cost of the coach and entrance into the museum. Free School Meal children will be required to pay £12.50. Payments can be made by instalment. Please note refunds for absence on the day cannot be made.

All children are required to wear school uniform, please ensure children bring along a waterproof coat and wear sensible outdoor footwear. Please note children will spend a lot of the day outside and so may require extra clothing layers. All children will need a packed lunch. If your child receives Free School Meals they are entitled to a free packed lunch, please notify the school office as soon as possible if required.

Please make the appropriate payment via Parent Pay by Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June, you will also be asked to tick a consent box as part of the payment process which authorises your son/daughter to attend the trip.

Children who have prescribed medicines (e.g. Asthma Inhalers, Epi-pens etc.) MUST bring these with them.
