Message from Mrs Grainger

Last week we were joined by 5 Headteacher's and Senior Leaders from other Community Academies Trust schools (we also visit their schools), for our annual peer review which is part of every school's development. You may have spoken to some of them on the playground before and after school. This was a very positive experience for us and there was recognition of the improvements made since the last visit and especially since September. The visitors particularly commented upon the excellent learning behaviour of the children in all year groups and that the general behaviour and courtesy of the children was a strength of the school. They very much enjoyed their visit.

On Wednesday the children in Years 2-6 had a visit from a travelling theatre company. This was kindly paid for by the PTFA – a big thank you to them. The children watched 'The B Word'. The production centred around the serious effects of bullying and what the consequences can be. It helps the children to understand the difference between bullying and falling out and explores key questions, such as; What is bullying? Why do people bully? and What can be done about bullying? It also explored cyber bullying and looked at the concept of being brave and the importance of telling. Qualities of a good friend and the anti-bullying message is repeated throughout, reinforcing learning and delivering a powerful message.

We finish for school today for February half-term and will return to school on Monday 26th February. Wishing you all a happy and safe half-term.

Year Group Updates

Nursery & Reception

This week Early Years have been celebrating Pancake Day, Valentine's Day and Chinese New Year. The children have made their own Chinese lanterns, pancakes, heart cookies using playdough, writing Chinese symbols, writing Valentine's Day and Chinese New Year cards and completing addition numbers sentences using heart sweets.

Year 1 & 2

In Years 1 and 2 we have been discussing bullying, friendship and how to be a good friend.

The children are writing an information leaflet about Chadsmead Primary Academy.

As part of our Street Detective topic the children have created observational drawings and model images of different types of building.

In Maths we have been focusing on dividing amounts equally.

Year 3 & 4

We've been writing some really interesting dilemma stories this week in Years 3 and 4.

The children have discussed a number of different scenarios and what they would do if faced with a difficult decision. They have then written a story using a huge range of writing skills including conjunctions, fronted adverbials, expanded noun phrases, paragraphs and dialogue.

Year 5

This week Year 5 have been investigating air resistance. They have designed, made and tested parachutes made from different materials to see which one makes the best one.

In maths lessons children have been challenged with some tricky problem solving questions. One of our focuses is solving problems in maths and strategies to tackle them. The children are showing improvements in their approach and attitude towards challenging tasks.

Year 6 - We have had a really enjoyable half term working on our 'Blood Heart' theme.
